Sparkling

Saracen Estates Vintage 2010 Margaret River \$40

Made by winemaker Bob Cartwright of the famed Leeuwin Estate, it has spent 9 years on lees for this 3rd disgorgement. With attractive buttery characteristics on the palate and sherbet like acidity interwoven with very fine mousse. This wine is every bit as good as a Vintage French Champagne and an absolute steal at this price.

Delamere Sparkling Rose NV Pipers River Tasmania \$50

100% Pinot Noir from a 2016 base with 21% being reserved from 2014. This wine exhibits delicious complexity with musk and strawberries shining through. Perfect with the salmon gravlax or the Greek salad.

White

Shaw & Smith Sauvignon Blanc 2020 Adelaide Hills \$50

This iconic Australian Sav Blanc needs no introduction. The 2020 is no less exceptional than any other year. Enjoy with the salt and pepper squid or the flathead tacos.

Dukes Single Vineyard Riesling 2020 \$45

Some may remember Dukes Riesling winning James Halliday's wine of the year in 2018. It is the first time a Riesling has ever won wine of the year. This vintage was awarded 97 points and on their website it reads, "As good as we have ever made". Amazing!

Holm Oak Chardonnay 2018 Tamar Valley Tasmania \$48

Cool climate chardonnay brilliance here in every sip. 100% Wild ferment with intense white peach and cashew aromas, the palate is medium bodied and well-rounded with an elegant creaminess. Finishes with a lick of freshness. Try with the marinara.

Rose

Ravenscroft Sagrantino Rose 2020 Granite Belt \$40

The grapes for this Italian variety were grown in Victoria's Riverina district and shipped to Ravenscroft, a local boutique winery where Mark expertly crafted this wine. Light and fresh with berry fruits and a moreish savoury, smoky finish. It will pair beautifully with the whiting or the chicken Kiev.

Red

Priory Ridge Pinot Noir St Helens Tasmania 2018 \$53

A delicious Burgundian style Pinot with dark cherries and plums. A fruit forward style that only could come from Tasmania. From a small boutique vineyard, this is worth a try. A match made in heaven with the steak sandwich.

Berrigan Shiraz 2018 Mount Benson SA \$40

This one has won many awards and is a steal at this price. It exhibits all the things you would require in a SA Shiraz and then some. From a small boutique winery with white pepper, lush fruit and very moreish. This pairs beautifully with the lamb or mushroom risotto.

Windance Estate Cabernet Merlot 2019 Margaret River \$48

Winning numerous awards, including 2 trophies for best Bordeaux blend, this 100% organic wine is a rare find. The palate offers mulberry, cassis and chocolate, supported by well-integrated French oak creating a smooth, velvety finish. Hello Eye Fillet!
